

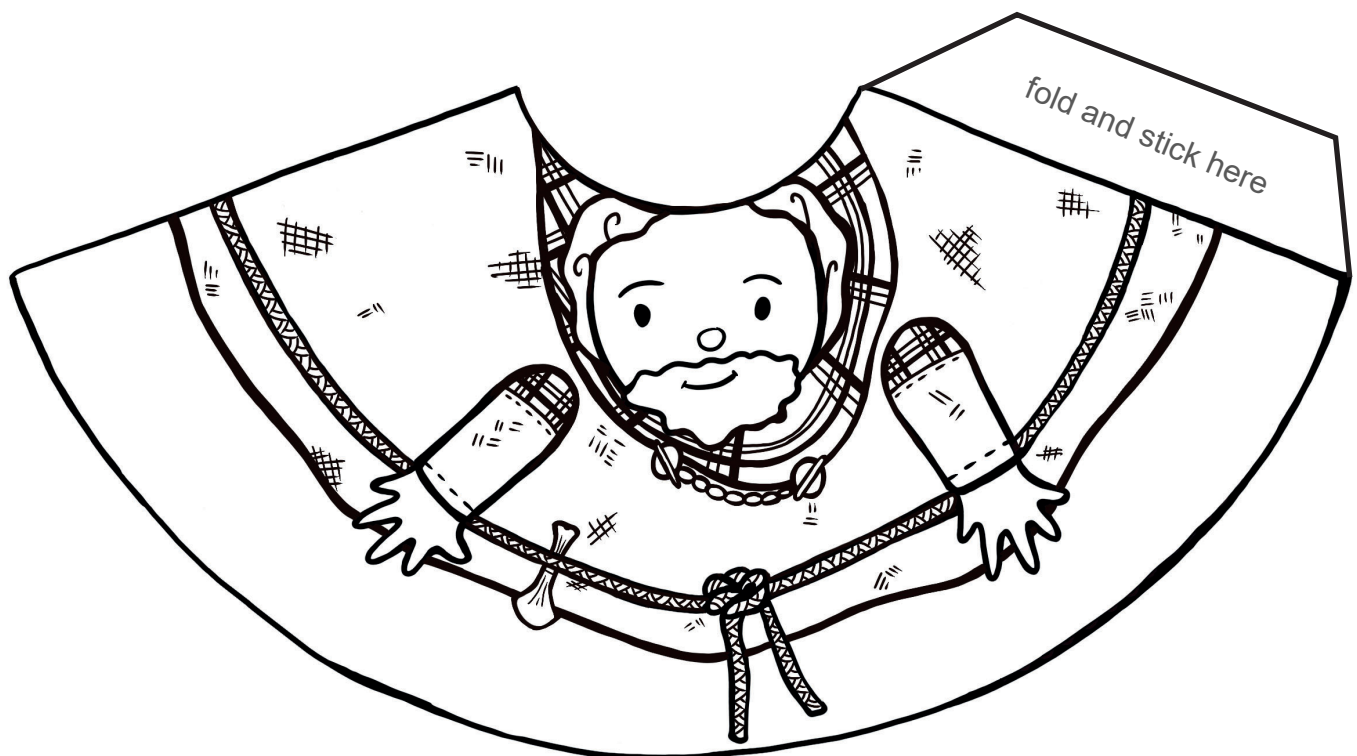
Make your own Iron Age Settler!

Step 1. Colour in your Iron Age settler

Step 2. Cut all around the outside of the settler along the thick black line

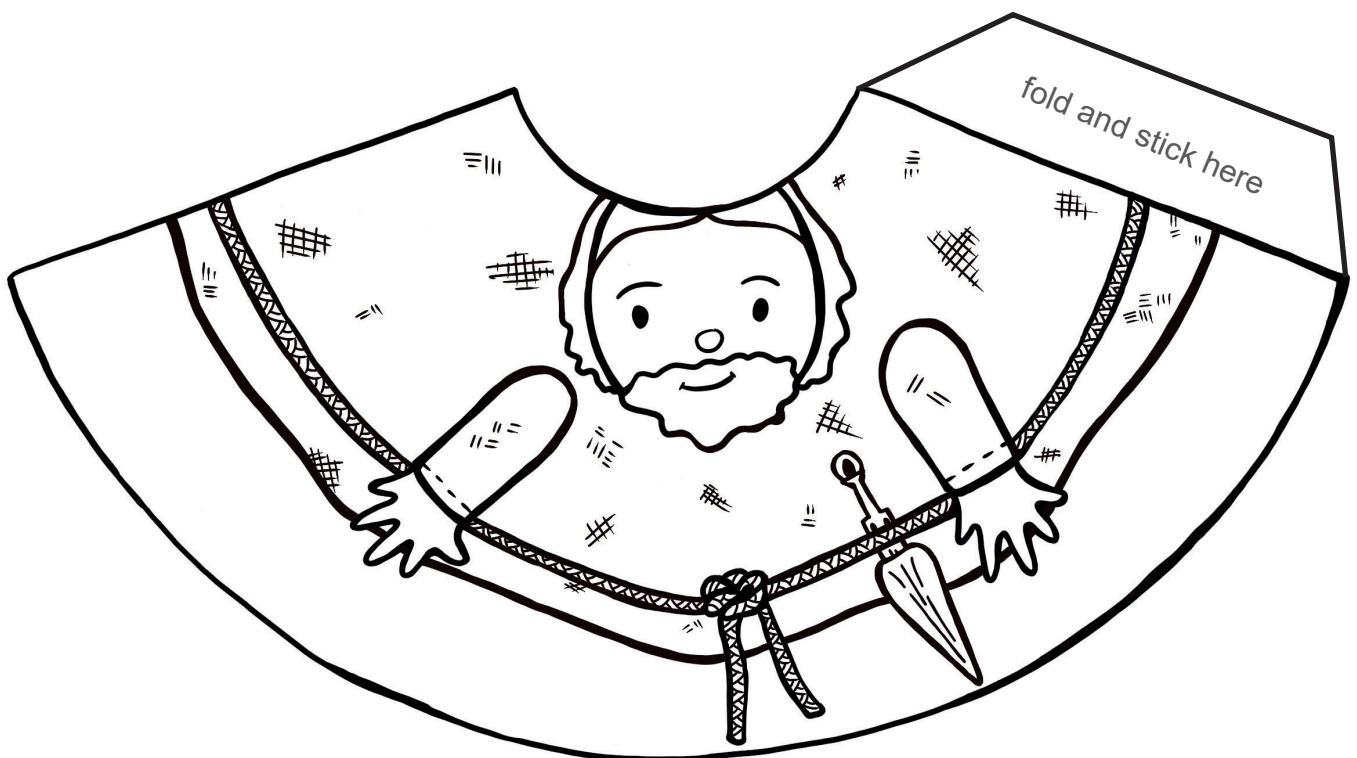
Step 3. Fold along the tab at the end of the settler and put a bit of glue along the edge

Step 4. Carefully curve your paper Iron Age person so that the blank tab goes under the opposite end of your settler. You now have a cone Iron Age settler, ready to set up a hillfort!



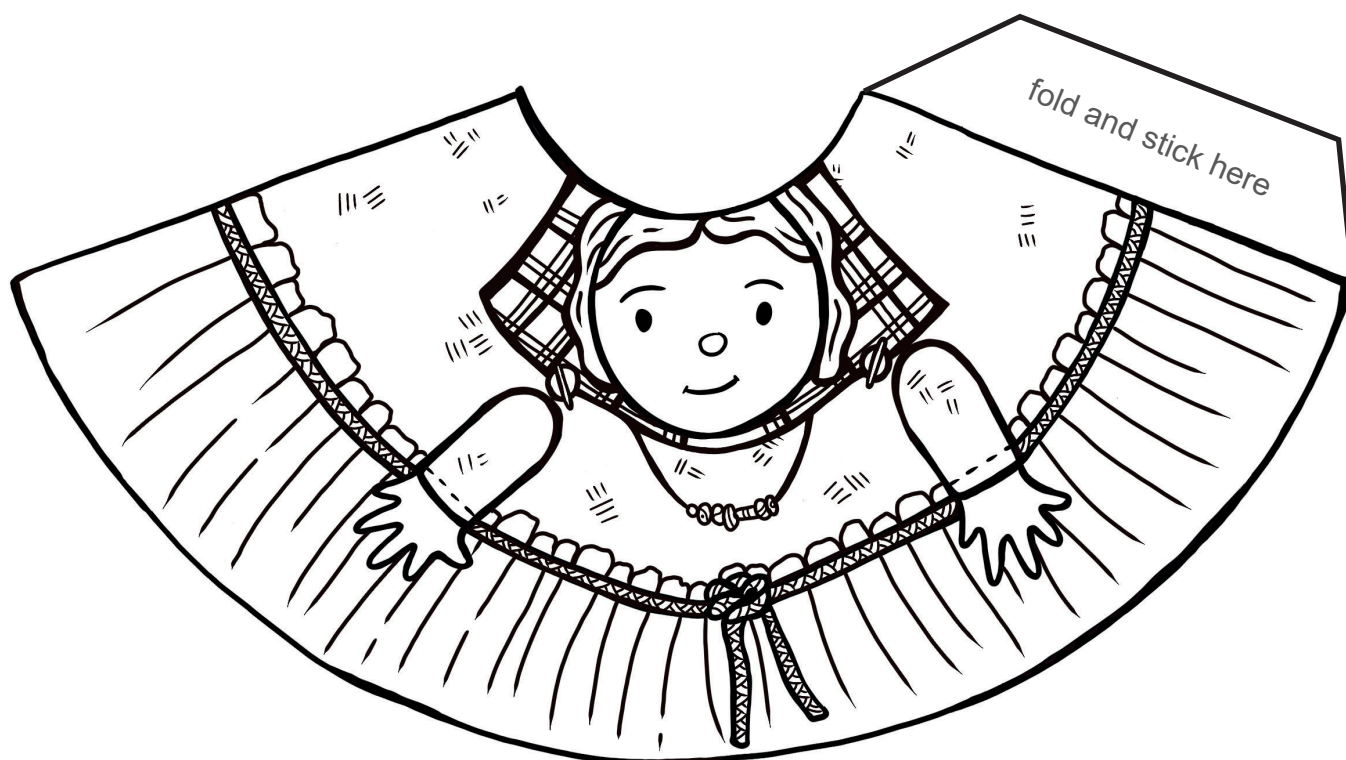
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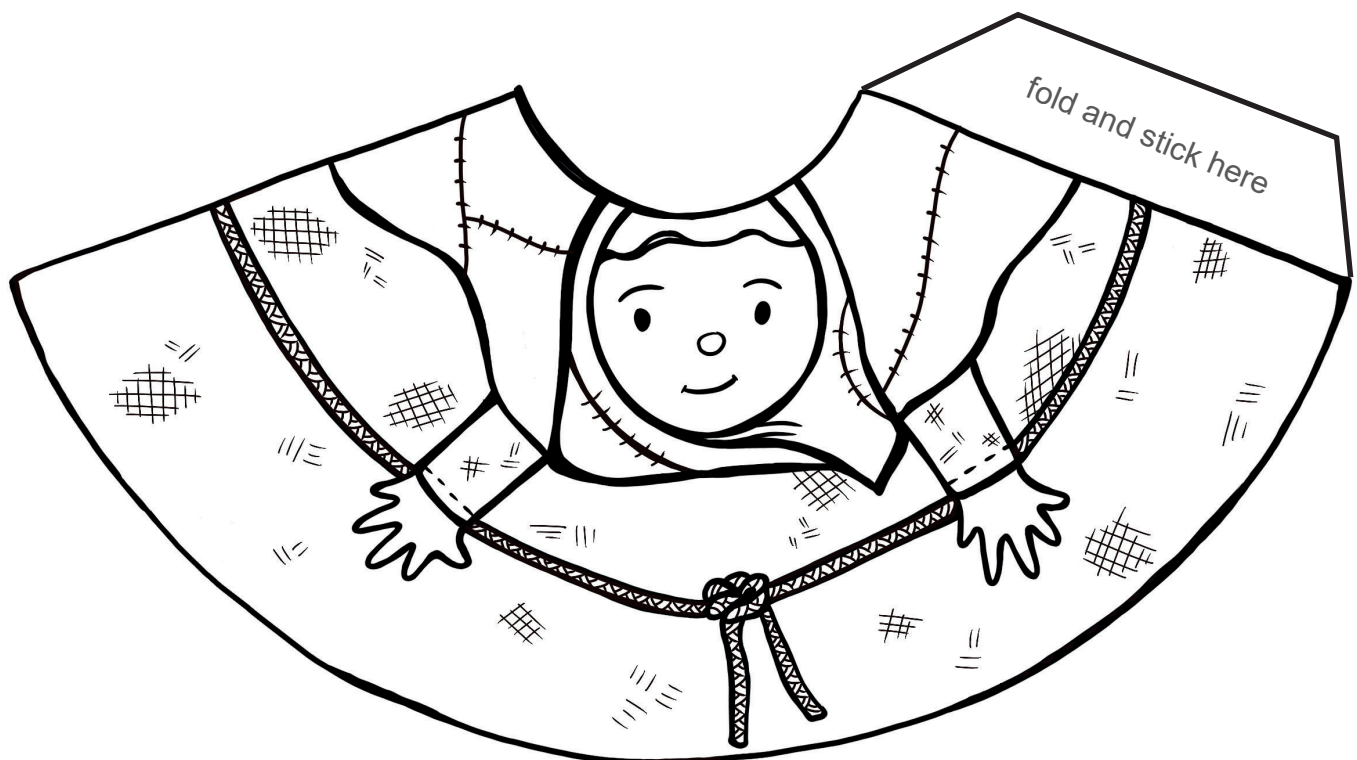
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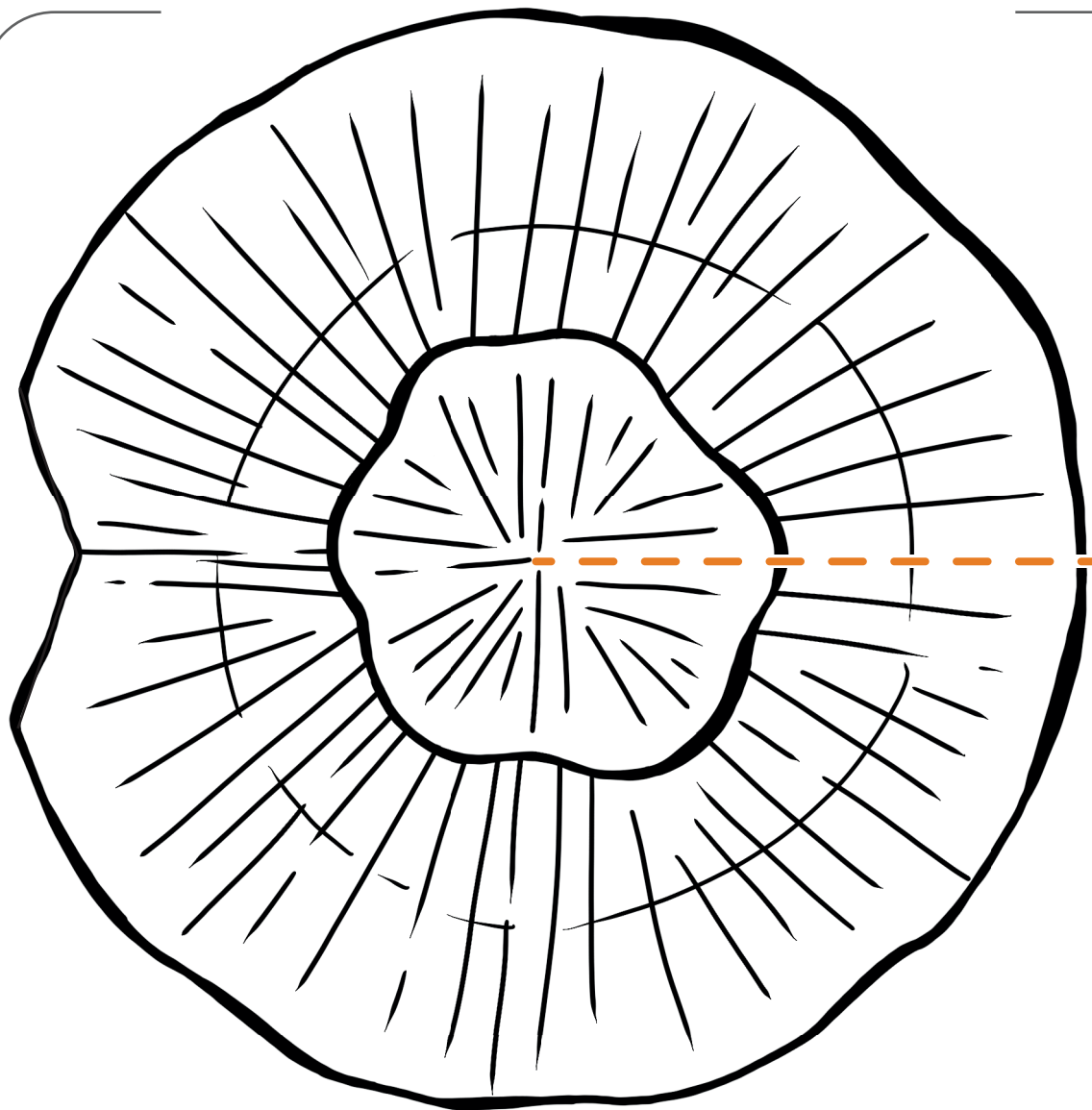
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Build Your Own Iron Age Roundhouse



1. Colour your house
2. Cut around the outline of your house and roof
3. Cut along the dotted line on your roof
4. Apply glue under the edge of one side of your dotted line
5. Fold one half of your roof over the other so that it starts to form a cone. Do this until you are happy with the height of your cone roof then stick your glued edge down to keep your shape in place
6. Do the same to your house base, gluing then folding until the dotted line below is covered
7. Place your roof on top of your house base and voila!
